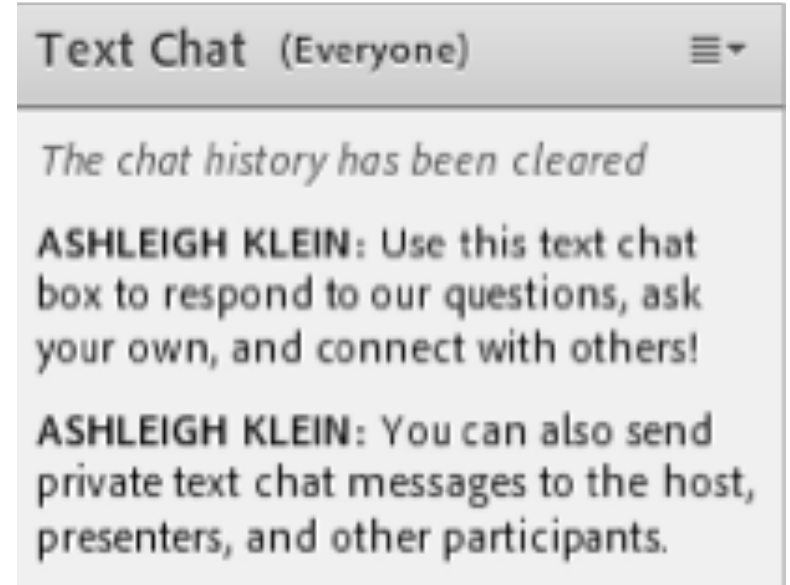
# eTAG

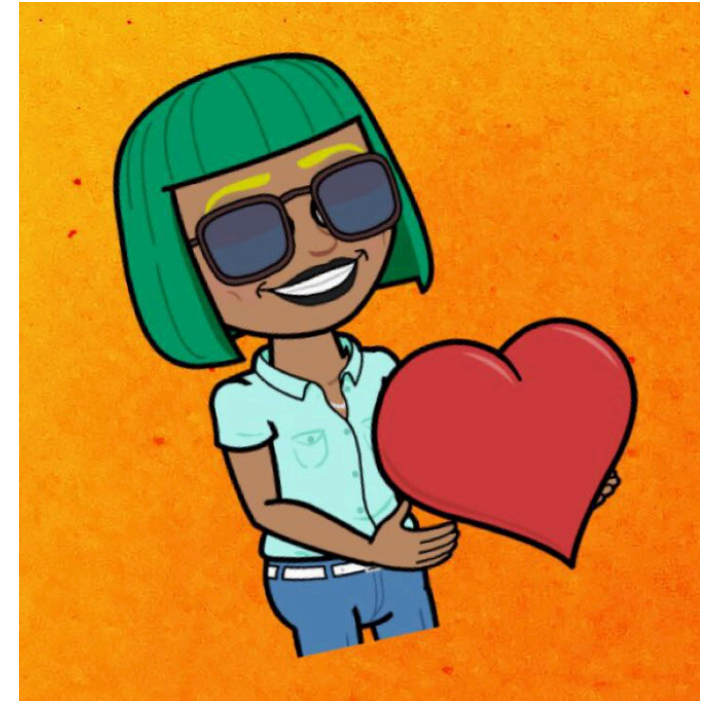
# Background

"Technology offers more opportunities for abusers and, unfortunately, the misuse of technology poses additional challenges for investigators and prosecutors who may not be familiar with the types of digital evidence that will be needed at trial."



# Build capacity of youth-serving adults to...

- Support youth survivors' autonomy
- Know local laws and their limitations
- Build partnerships and cross-training opportunities with youth-serving adults in other disciplines
- Implement survivor-centered, youth-informed safety planning strategies
- Navigate legal and non-legal remedies to address tech abuse from a trauma-informed care lens
- Prevent tech abuse among youth

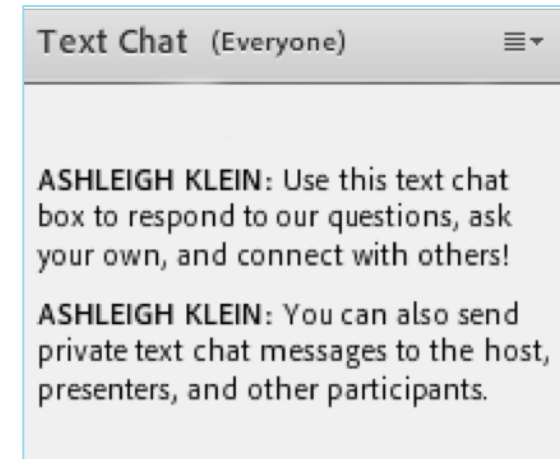

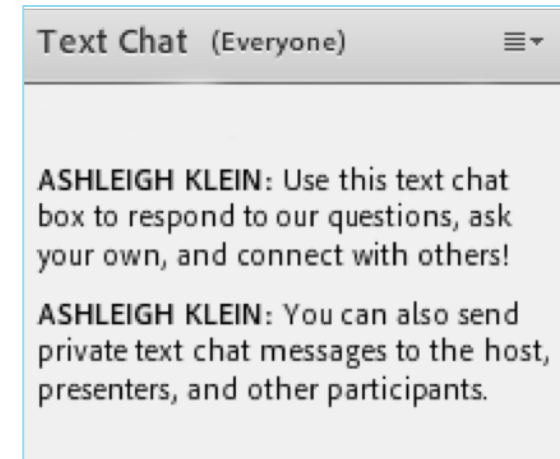
